#### **Tiger Woods Wins First Championship In 5 Years**

Yesterday, Monday, Tiger Woods won the 2018 tour championship by 2 shots, completing the round in 71 shots, which is 11 under par. This was his first tournament win since 2013 and it was an astonishing comeback<sup>4</sup>. The crowd were amazed, and so was he. He takes home the \$9 million prize which he can add to the almost \$1 billion he has. He is pretty much the wealthiest sports person in the world.





He has had a difficult decade. After shooting to fame<sup>5</sup> in 1996 when he was 20 years old. Since then he has won 80 PGA tour tournaments, only 2 off American Sam Snead. Tiger won his last tournament in 2013 before suffering a back injury<sup>6</sup>. He has had a succession of operations which, finally, seem to have worked. His back is back to form. Also, he had a highly public breakup with his wife and a car accident.

He was also arrested in 2016 for driving under the influence of drugs<sup>7</sup>. Tiger was asleep in his car at the side of the road. He said that he had taken pain killers for his back and had fallen asleep. He wasn't actually driving. Anyway, this victory shows that he could be back to form. The crowds certainly seemed to think so and, as he moved up the leaderboard, the number of people who turned up to watch him steadily<sup>8</sup> grew. Is he still the greatest golfer in the world? Time will tell.
