

- 1. The oldest known farm was from the Middle East<sup>3</sup> and it is 12,000 years old.

- 3. The largest farm in the world is the Anna Creek Station in Australia. It is 24,000 km2, which would make it the 146<sup>th</sup> largest country, bigger than Israel.
- 4. A lot of young people don't want to work on farms these days, so farms are joining together to become larger and they are becoming automated<sup>6</sup>. Many of them use automatic drones, tractors, and harvesting<sup>7</sup> machines.
- 5. A lot of farms rent bees. Every year, their crops need to be pollinated<sup>8</sup>, and professional bee keepers bring millions of bees to the farm.

## World record

Let's have some egg records this week. The largest egg of a living animal is the ostrich<sup>1</sup> egg. They are about 15 cm long and weigh 1.4 kg. That is about 20 times larger than a chicken egg. The largest eggs of any animal (that we know about) were the eggs of a dinosaur called Beibeilong. It was a giant oviraptorosaur and. Its eggs were about 45 cm long and weighed about 5 kg. The most expensive egg in the world is not actually a real egg. Have you ever heard of Fabergé eggs? They are works of art made by a jewellery firm<sup>2</sup> called The House of Fabergé. They are made to look like eggs, but they are made of

precious metals<sup>3</sup> and jewels. They were made for the Russian Imperial family and have become a symbol of opulence<sup>4</sup>. The Russian Imperial family's use of money was one of the reasons for the Russian Revolution<sup>5</sup>. The most expensive Fabergé egg is called the Third Imperial Easter Egg and it was sold for \$33 million. 69 eggs were made, and 12 have disappeared. One was found recently.
