

World record

are some scooter world records. I bet¹ you can't guess what the fastest 5 meters on a scooter by a parrot is? Well, it's 14.58 seconds. The parrot is called Chico and he has his own little bird-sized scooter. He is very fast and very cute. On the other end of the scale², the world record for the biggest

An Unusual Job

Foley Artist

You have probably never heard of a Foley artist⁴, but if you have watched a movie to the end, you will have seen their name on the screen. A Foley artist makes sounds and sound effects for movies, TV shows, video games, and many other things. Quite often, when people make a movie, all of the sound doesn't get picked up by the mics, or maybe there is too much background noise, or maybe the sound (even though it is real) doesn't sound real. The job of a Foley artist is to recreate⁵ these sounds in a sound studio. They use any materials they can think of and a high-quality microphone to make sounds. A good Foley artist can recreate any sound you might hear with some objects that you would never think of. For example, the sound of fire is made by crumpling up⁶ cellophane or a bag of potato chips. The sound of walking on snow is made by squashing cornstarch⁷ in a leather pouch. The sound of rain on an umbrella can be made from frying bacon. And, how do you think they make kissing sounds? Quite often the romantic sounds you hear are the Foley artist kissing their own arm! Foley artists work in a studio with lots of these props, but they are constantly⁸ finding more things to make sound with. It sounds like a very interesting job. What do you think?
