Something you didn't know about CAT scans⁴

- 1. CAT stands for Computerized Axial Tomography. "Computerized" means by computer. "Axial" means across an axis. "Tomography" means imaging something by sections.
- 2. The CAT scanner was invented in 1972. The two inventors won a Nobel prize.
- 3. CAT scanners take many X-ray images in cross sections⁵, like a loaf of bread, and then puts them together.
- 4. Sometimes patients⁶ drink a contrast dye⁷ so that different parts of the body show up more easily on the scan.
- 5. CAT scans are much faster than MRI scans.

Italian Doctor Gives His Cat a CAT Scan

In Rome, Italy, a doctor has gone viral after using a hospital's CT scanner to check on his sick cat. The doctor, who works at a hospital in the city of Arezzo, brought his pet in after the cat fell off the roof. The CT scanner, also called a CAT scan, is usually used for humans. It takes detailed images of the inside of the body to help doctors find injuries⁹ or illnesses. However, in this unusual case, the doctor decided to use it on his pet. He then operated on 10 his cat. Hospital staff were surprised to see the cat inside the machine. Some found it amusing, but others were not happy because the scanner is meant for human patients. Reports say that the doctor performed the scan outside of normal hospital hours, when no patients were waiting. After the story spread online, many people reacted with mixed opinions. Some animal lovers praised the doctor for caring about his pet. Ohers, including hospital officials, said the machine should only be used for people. The hospital has since launched an investigation¹¹ to see if any rules were broken. The cat's condition has not been fully reported, but sources say it is now doing fine. Meanwhile, the doctor may face consequences¹² for using hospital equipment in an unusual way. What do vou think?

World record

Do you have a cat or a dog? I have a cat, but it seems that more people in the world have dogs. There is no way to get an exact figure¹, but it is estimated² that there are 600 million pet cats in the world and 900 million pet dogs. Here are some cat world records. The biggest domestic cat³ is the Maine Coon. They are generally about 10 kg and 41 cm tall, but the biggest ever Maine Coon was 50 cm tall and 123 cm long (including its tail). We all know that cats can jump a long way. The record for longest cat jump is 3.3 m. That doesn't sound very far, but remember how small they are. The snow leopard, which is a cat, can jump over 15 m! The average cat can jump over 2 m vertically⁴, but a tiger can vertically jump 5 m! There have even been reports of tigers jumping over 6 m! The world record for the heaviest domestic cat was called Meow and he weighed 18 kg. Domestic cats are still pretty small. The heaviest known cat, a liger (a cross between a lion and a
